

INTRODUCTION

Educational Institutions play an important role in meeting the individual and collective needs and aspirations of the people of a country. It is, therefore, expedient to establish a standard institution which can inculcate in the youth, the ideal and aspirations of the nation emphasizing spiritual values of equality, tolerance and social justice.



Jabbir Bin Hayyan (Muslim Scientist recognized as the father of Chemistry) Trust is a vibrant NGO working in the areas of education, socio economics and basic health facilities in rural areas of Pakistan, with focus on education. It has a network of USWA PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND COLLEGES in the far-flung rural areas of Pakistan.

It was a cherished desire to establish a quality residential institution in Chakwal District. The College was initially established in a rented building at Chakwal in July 2008. Some philanthropists have generously donated an area Total 100 Kanal of land at Dhudial/ some land also purchased, where College has been established since April 2008. The construction is gradually in progress keeping in view the future requirements.

MISSION

USWA COLLEGE CHAKWAL (Dhudial) is entrusted to educate and groom the students physically, mentally and intellectually with a view to polishing their intellect for their onward pursuits in practical life. The College is committed to provide modern quality education with emphasis on science and technology. Character and moral building by creating conducive environment including correct and balance approach based on beliefs of Islam and love of humanity.

Poverty would not be allowed to become hindrance in getting quality education for the deserving students by providing financial assistance through various means.

IMPORTANCE OF EDUCATION IN ISLAM

The revelation of the Holy Quran commenced with very teaching of the word "Read" which is a manifestation of the significance of education in Islam. The history of mankind is fraught with the instances of the importance of knowledge. Man is the vice regent of God on earth only because of his knowledge. On the creation of man, Angels were ordered to bow before Adam, the first human being, due to his superiority upon them in terms of knowledge. Moreover there are a number of traditions of the Holy Prophet (PBUH) throwing light upon the importance of Education, about sixty non-believers were held as prisoners of war, whom the Holy Prophet gave the task of educating Muslims, at the completion of which they were set free. Besides another tradition relating to education is, the ink of scholar is holier than the blood of martyr.

INDUCTION

Student will be inducted in class VI once in a year. However limited seats in class VII and VIII are available this year. Five to seven years of education at the College will enable them to obtain Intermediate certificate from the Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education Rawalpindi after passing their examinations.

ADMISSION

Students are inducted in class VI once a year in accordance with the prescribed schedule advertised from time to time. The candidates must be between the ages of 10 to 12 years for class VI, II to 13 years for class VII and 12 to 14 Years for class VIII on 01 April. No relaxation of age limit what so ever is permitted. The application will be received till month of January. Admission Tests will be conducted in month of March.

- a. Selection will be made on the basis of written test in Mathematics, English, Urdu and Science followed by an interview and medical fitness test.
- **b.** Applications for appearing in written test are invited on prescribed form through advertisement.(Copy attached)
- c. Tests will be held at Gilgit, Skardu, Peshawar, Layyah, Muzaffarabad (AJK)Islamabad and Subject to strenght of candidates of the area Dhudial (Chakwal) but final interview and medical examination will be taken at Uswa College Chakwal (Dhudial).

Note:

In case it is not feasible to hold the entrance written test at any one of the Centers mentioned above, the candidates of that Center shall be asked to appear at another Center.

REGISTRATION FEE

Every candidate will be required to remit non refundable registration fee of **Rs. 500/-** with application form. Following documents must be attached with the application form:-

- Student studying certificate.
- b. Birth certificate of Union Council and attested copy of Form "B" (NADRA). Moreover the physical appearance of the candidate must correspond with the mentioned age.
- c. Photo copy of parents/guardian's CNIC.
- d. Five latest photographs of the candidate.

DRESS

UNIFORM

Uniform is the symbol of discipline and mark of distinction, identification and creates a sense of pride among students. Neat and clean uniform is required according to weather conditions as follows. Will be provided by college on cash payment.

Summer:

White shirt with full sleeves, grey worsted trouser black oxford shoes with toe and grey socks

White shirt with full sleeves, grey worsted trouser black oxford shoes with toe, green long stockings, maroon full sleeves jersey and maroon coat. (To be purchased from College Canteen).

1 x Scouts Uniform.

Bedding: Bed sheets, Pillow (quilt during winter)

Clothes: 3 sets of Shalwar Kameez (white).

Dress Shirt and pent: Students choice to be brought along.

 The students will bring following items upon joining the college:-

Towel, bath Soap case, Comb, Toothbrush, Shoe Polish, Shoe Brush, one pair of Slippers, Briefcase and Bag. Subsequent replacement will be done at students expense.

CURRICULA / EXAMINATIONS

The College is affiliated with the Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education Rawalpindi for the purpose of **SSC** and **HSSC** Examinations. Curricula of the board is followed.

The College policy with regard to examination is as under:-

- Students will prepare for SSC and HSSC examinations according to the examination system of the BISE Rawalpindi.
- For internal assessment and monitoring, efforts will be made to equip the students with the skills relating to the board examination by conducting monthly and terminal Tests. The result of which will be communicated to the parents for their information at the end of every term.
- The student, who fails in the Annual Examination, will be detained in the same class <u>OR</u> discharged from the College based upon his performance.

Students are accommodated in 4x houses. House Masters have been appointed for each House assisted by AHM, House Prefect, AHP and room Prefect.




MESS

Leave

Consecutive absence of seven days without application will render a student struck off the roll, after which re-admission will require the payment of full admission fee exclusive of re-fundable security.
